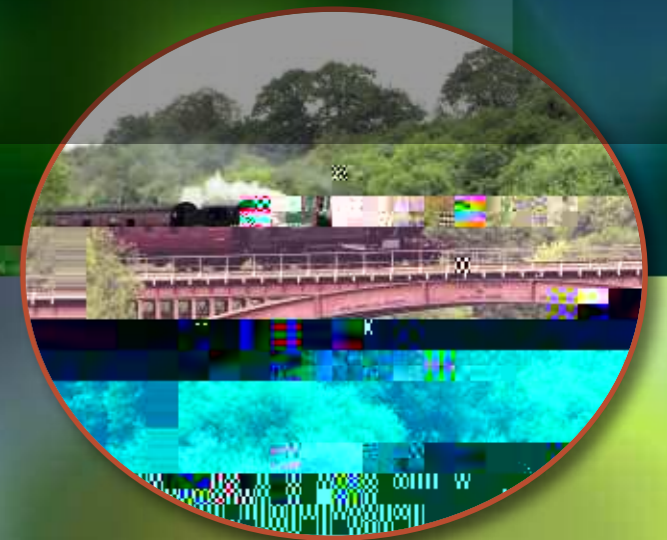

A 4 (or 8) mile Circular Waymarked Trail

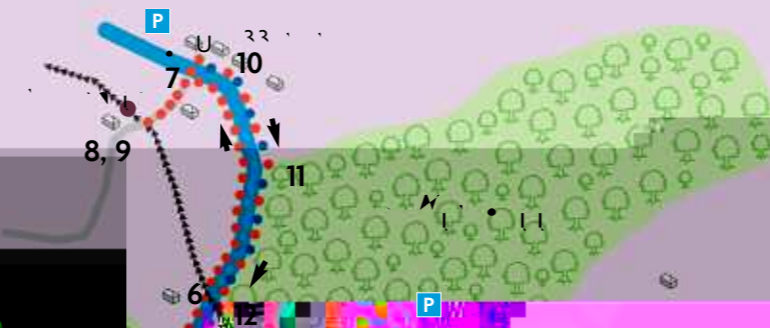
