<b>Brief Description Of Decision</b>	<p>The Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Adult Social Care:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) considered the outcomes of the service user re-assessments and support plans and supported and accepted the professionals' reassurance that individuals' eligible needs could be met with the proposed new use of buildings in Droitwich;</li><li>(b) approved the final decision to use the proposed buildings for Council-provided day services for adults with a learning disability as set out in paragraph 12 of the published report; and</li><li>(c) requested the Director of Adult Services and Health to proceed to implement this decision in line with the report with immediate effect.</li></ul>
