Brief Description Of Decision	<p>To:</p> <p>(a) approve the revised Minerals and Waste Local Development Scheme for Worcestershire (April 2015);</p> <p>(b) delegate authority to the Director of Business, Environment and Community in consultation with the Cabinet Member to approve the preparation of the Minerals Local Plan and the necessary consultations in accordance with the Local Development Order and any amendments to it, without the need for further formal approval by Cabinet; and</p> <p>(c) confirm that the final version of the Minerals Local Plan and supporting documents will be returned to Cabinet and Council for approval before they are formally published for public comment and submitted to the Secretary of State for Examination in line with statutory regulations.</p>
Reason(s) For Decision	<p>The revised Minerals and Waste Local Development Scheme for Worcestershire is updated and realistic. The revised Mineral and Waste Local Development Scheme will enable businesses and the public to understand and contribute to the preparation of the Minerals Local Plan up to its adoption and to understand how it will fit in with the existing Waste Core Strategy Development Plan will be monitored.</p>
