Definitions

Children Looked After and previously Children Looked After, including those who appear to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.

all those currently in the care of a Local Authority or accommodated by a Local Authority under the terms of the Children Act 1989 and children who were previously in the care of or accommodated by a Local Authority but immediately after being looked after, became subject to an adoption, a child arrangements order or special guardianship order and includes those children who appear to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state case as a result of being adopted. By children previously in state care outside of England, we mean children who have been looked after outside of England by a public authority, a religious organisation or another provider of care whose sole purpose is to benefit society. The care may have been provided in orphanages or other settings. Independent supporting evidence will be required to be provided with the application.

Children of Staff

Home is defined as the only or main residential address at the time of application where the young person normally resides and which is the address of the parent/carer with main responsibility for the young person. Documentary evidence may be required.
